## How to Use These Games

These Bingo games are a wonderful way to teach your students about Saint Patrick.

Use the prompts found on the next page to quiz your students on their knowledge of St Patrick and his life. When they answer the prompt, they look for the image on their card. It's Bingo with a twist!

Play these in your Catholic home school, your religious education classroom, your Catholic co-op, or in the Catholic classroom.



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## Bingo Prompts

Ask your students the following questions. When they answer correctly, they look for the corresponding image on their Bingo card.

You can also play in standard Bingo fashion, simply calling out the images. The prompts provide a fun twist on reviewing facts.

1. A Symbol of Ireland and St. Patrick: Celtic Cross
2. A legend about St. Patrick: Driving the snakes out of Ireland
3. What was St. Patrick's job when he was young? Shepherd
4. Who kidnapped St. Patrick? Pirates
5. This happens sometime when you sleep: Dream
6. Shepherds take care of these animals: Sheep
7. Look for the image of a mother and baby: St. Patrick and his mother
8. Where we go to Mass: Church
9. St. Patrick used this to teach about the Trinity: Shamrock
10. What we can do to imitate St. Patrick? help others
11. What role did St. Patrick hold in the Church? Bishop
12. According to legend, St. Patrick drove these animals out of Ireland: Snakes
